A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT AND ORDERING THE LEVY FOR THE LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/20

The City Council (the "Council") of the City of Union City (the "City") does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Council previously completed its proceedings in accordance with and pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500) (the "Act") to establish the City's Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District No. 3 (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the City has retained NBS for the purpose of assisting with the annual levy of the District, and to prepare and file an Annual Report; and

WHEREAS, the City has, by previous resolution, declared its intention to hold a Public Hearing concerning the levy and collection of assessments within the District; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing has been held and concluded and notice thereof was duly given in accordance with Section 22626 of the Act; and

WHEREAS, at the time and place specified in the Resolution of Intention the City conducted such hearing and considered all objections to the assessment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Confirmation of Assessment and Diagram: The Council hereby confirms the assessment and the diagram as is described in full detail in the Annual Report on file with the Clerk.
- Levy of Assessment: Pursuant to Section 22631 of the Act, the adoption of this resolution shall constitute the levy of an assessment for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.
- **3.** Ordering of the Levy: The Council hereby orders City Staff with the assistance of NBS to prepare and submit the levy of assessments to Alameda County for placement on the Fiscal Year 2019/20 secured property tax roll.
- **4. Appropriate Annual Levy:** The Council hereby appropriates the 511 Zone and Brookstone assessments into the Public Works Grounds Maintenance Programs.
