Background

- The POA contract expired June 30, 2019
- Negotiations have been conducted in good faith and tentative agreements have been reached
- The City Council has been kept appraised of the progress and have provided the appropriate bargaining authority



Section 2.00 Compensation

- Effective July 1, 2019 3.00% COLA
- Effective January 1, 2020 3.00% COLA
- Effective January 1, 2021 3.00% COLA



Section 2.00 Compensation (cont)

- Effective July 1, 2019 2.50% COLA
 - 2.50% longevity at 12 years has been eliminated



Section 2.11 (B) Specialty Pay

 Effective July 1, 2019 a 5% specialty pay will be given to unit members assigned to the traffic unit



Section 2.11 (C) Specialty Pay

- Effective July 1, 2019 a 7.5% specialty pay will be given to unit members assigned to the Field Training Officer program (FTO)
 - Increase from the previous FTO rate of 5%
 - Reduces the number of FTO's from 13 part time assignments to 8 full time assignments
 - Assignment is a full time responsibility vs previously considered a temporary assignment



Section 4.10 Vacation

 Effective with the first pay period in December 2019, change the vacation accrual schedule as follows

0-3 yrs

• 4-8 yrs

• 9-13 yrs

9-12 yrs

• 14-18 yrs

13-15 yrs

16+ yrs



Section 13.00 Duration

 The duration of the MOU is July 1, 2019 – December 31, 2021
