# **Redistricting Process**

Step	Description
Census Data Release August 12, 2021	Census Bureau releases official 2020 Census population data
<b>California Data Release</b> September 20, 2021	California Statewide Database releases California's official 'prisoner- adjusted' 2020 redistricting data
<b>California Data Release</b> Early October 2021	<ul> <li>California Statewide Database releases California's official 'prisoner- adjusted' 2020 redistricting data.</li> </ul>
Public Hearing #1 November 9, 2021	<ul> <li>Held prior to release of draft maps</li> <li>Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest</li> </ul>
Redistricting Webpage Launch ~November 15, 2021	<ul> <li>Dedicated website for community members to track the redistricting process through completion at <u>http://drawunioncity.org</u></li> </ul>



# **Redistricting Process (continued)**

Step	Description
<b>Public Submit Draft Maps</b> January 11, 2022	<ul><li>Two weeks after final pre-draft hearing</li><li>Two weeks prior to first post-draft hearing</li></ul>
Public Hearing #2 January 25, 2022	<ul> <li>Held after release of draft maps</li> <li>Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest</li> <li>Discuss and revise draft maps; discuss election sequencing</li> </ul>
Public Hearing #3 February 22, 2021	• Public and Council deliberation on Map options. Council vote on preferred map and introduce the ordinance.
Public Hearing #4 March 8, 2021	Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption. Map adopted via ordinance.



# **Redistricting Rules and Goals**

#### 1. Federal Laws

Equal Population Federal Voting Rights Act No Racial Gerrymandering





#### 2. California Criteria for Cities

1. Geographically contiguous

#### 2. Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest"

(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)

- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries
- Compact (Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

#### **Prohibited:**

"Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."

#### 3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

Minimize voters shifted to different election years

Respect voters' choices / continuity in office

Future population growth

Preserving the core of existing districts

### Demographic Summary of Existing Districts

Estimates using official 2020 demographic data and NDC's estimated total population figures.


> Each of the 4 districts must contain about 17,555 people.



### Latino CVAP





# **Defining Neighborhoods**

1<sup>st</sup> Question: What is your neighborhood?

2<sup>nd</sup> Question: What are its geographic boundaries?

Examples of physical features defining a neighborhood boundary:

- Natural neighborhood dividing lines, such as highway or major roads, rivers, canals and/or hills
- Areas around parks or schools
- Other neighborhood landmarks

In the absence of public testimony, planning records and other similar documents may provide definition.





## Beyond Neighborhoods: Defining Communities of Interest

1st Question: What defines your community?

- Geographic Area, plus
- □ Shared issue or characteristic
  - □ Shared social or economic interest
  - Impacted by county policies
- □ Tell us "your community's story"

2<sup>nd</sup> Question: Would this community benefit from being "included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation"?

• Or would it benefit more from having multiple representatives?

Definitions of Communities of Interest may <u>not</u> include relationships with political parties, incumbents, or political candidates.

  - □ Paper- and Excel-based simple "Draw a draft map" tools


Whether you use the powerful (but complicated) online mapping tool, Excel, the paper kit, or just draw on a napkin, we welcome your maps!



# Simple Map Drawing Tool


#### Paper "Public Participation Kit"
