RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SURPLUS FIRE ENGINE 529 AND APPROVE ITS SALE TO ALAMEDA COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY \$7,000 FOR THEIR TRAINING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Fire Engine 529 has been presented to the City Council to be declared surplus, in accordance with provisions of the City's Municipal Code Section 2.32.250; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County Fire Department has requested that Fire Engine 529 be sold to them for use in their training program instead of disposed of at auction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the sale to Alameda County Fire Department for fair market value because it directly benefits the training of the fire department staff that serve Union City; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County Fire Department will remove applicable equipment from Engine 529 and transfer to Engine 531; and

WHEREAS, Engine 531 will be removed from service and used as a reserve fire engine that will initially located at Fire Station No. 31; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Union City hereby authorizes the City Manager to surplus Fire Engine 529 and sell it to Alameda County Fire Department in the amount of approximately \$7,000 for their training program with proceeds to be deposited into the Garage Equipment Replacement Fund (Fund 6122).
